
## **Mother's Day is May 14<sup>th</sup>!**

## New Product Spotlight: Bubble Thing

Blowing bubbles is one of the timeless childhood activities that everyone loves. We have a great new product, Bubble Thing, that will help you make the biggest bubbles you have ever seen!

Bubble Thing was invented in 1984 in Vinalhaven, Maine. In 1986 it was used to set the first Guinness World Record for soap bubbles - 50 feet!

The Bubble Thing is an 90-inch open-and-closable fabric loop blows bubbles all shapes and sizes up to 20-feet long and more. The starter kit includes one Bubble Thing and a Bubble Mix. Combine warm water, dish soap, and Bubble Mix in a bucket and you're all set to make some huge bubbles. We also have Bubble Mix Refills available for more fun.



## Recipe Corner

### Buffalo Chicken Pasta Salad



#### Ingredients:

- 1/2 lb. Spiral pasta, prepared as directed
- 2 cups Chicken, cooked and chopped (option: rotisserie chicken)
- 2-3 cups Romaine lettuce, chopped
- 1 cup Celery, chopped
- 1 cup Carrots, chopped
- 1/2 cup Red pepper, chopped
- 1 1/2 cups Robert Rothschild Buffalo Blue Cheese Dip



#### Directions:

Prepare pasta and rinse with cold water until pasta is completely cooled. Drain well and place in a large bowl. Add chicken and vegetables to pasta, tossing gently. Carefully dress the salad with the Buffalo Blue Cheese Dip, tossing lightly. Chill for 30 minutes before serving. If making ahead, reserve a small amount of dip to toss with the salad just before serving.
