Recipe Corner:

Dirty Martini Deviled Eggs

Ingredients:

6 eggs, hard-boiled

1/3 cup Mayonnaise

1/3 cup Robert Rothschild Dirty Martini Dip Salt and pepper to taste

Directions:

Cut eggs in half lengthwise and separate yolks from whites. Reserve egg white shells. Place egg yolks in a mixing bowl and break up with a fork. In another bowl combine the mayonnaise and the Dirty Martini Dip. Mix thoroughly and combine with the egg yolks. Taste for salt and pepper. Mound egg yolk mixture in each of the egg white halves.
