


## Spring is in the Air

## Recipe Corner

### Sinfully Delighting Coffee Mousse

#### Ingredients:

- 1 ¼ cup brewed coffee (chocolate flavor recommended)
- 48 regular size (not mini) white marshmallows
- 1 cup frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 1 tbsp finely ground coffee (same flavor as used above)
- 3 tbsp milk chocolate chips finely chopped

#### Instructions:

Place coffee in a medium saucepan and warm over medium heat until hot but not boiling. Add marshmallows and stir until melted. Place in a medium mixing bowl and refrigerate until cold, about 20 minutes. Gently fold in whipped topping, then swirl in coffee and chocolate chip pieces. Divide evenly among 6 parfait glasses or similar. Refrigerate until serving.
