

Zucchini Boats

<u>Ingredients:</u>

1 Bruschetta Cheeseball Mix 4 zucchini

- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup olive oil
- 2 small tomatoes, sliced
- 1 cup shredded cheese of choice

Directions:

Preheat over to 375 degrees or cook on the grill. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper; set aside. Cut each zucchini in half horizontally, then scoop out the seeds. Brush with olive oil and spring with dry cheeseball mix. Top with sliced tomato, cheese, and sprinkle with topping packet. Bake for 20-25 minutes until soft. Serve warm. Try

adding Toppings like olives, peppers and ground beef or turkey!
