RECIPE CORNER

Gouda & Asparagus Tart

PERFECT FOR EASTER BRUNCH

INGREDIENTS:

1 sheet puff pastry, thawed
1 cup shredded Gouda chees

1 bunch asparagus, trimmed

1 egg, beaten

tbsp Dijon mustard

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14 cup grated Parmesan cheese (optional for topping)

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 400°F and line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Roll out the puff pastry slightly and place on the baking sheet. Using a knife, lightly score a 1-inch border around the edges (don't cut through). Brush the center of the pastry with Dijon mustard, then sprinkle with shredded Gouda. Arrange the asparagus on top, trimming to fit within border. Brush the pastry edges with the beaten egg. Drizzle the asparagus with olive oil, then sprinkle with garlic powder and black pepper. Bake for 20–25 minutes, or until the pastry is golden and crispy. Remove from oven and sprinkle with Parmesan cheese if desired. Slice and serve warm.
