FROM THE Cabin Kitchen

Smoked Gouda Sausage Balls with Hot Honey

INGREDIENTS:

16oz Pork Sausage, thawed
12 oz smoked gouda, freshly grated
2 cups Bisquick
1-3 Tbsp milk (if needed)
Hot Honey

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Line a baking sheet with parchment paper. In a medium bowl, add raw sausage, smoked Gouda, and baking mix. Mix well with your hands until everything is incorporated. If the mixture is dry and too crumbly to come together, add milk 1 tablespoon at a time, until it will all hold together. For easier handling, chill the mixture for 15-30 minutes. Roll into 1-inch balls and transfer to baking sheet, spacing about 1 inch apart. Bake for 8-10 minutes, until golden brown. Serve with toothpicks immediately with spicy honey for dipping.
