Join us by bringing in your used socks. Any brand, color, size and materials are welcome, although merino is preferred. No rolled or paired socks, bags, rubber bands, paper clips - just single socks. Please be sure the socks are clean. We will have a container available by our counter for you to put them in. We've recycled over 65 pounds of socks over the last two years! And, we have some of the second cut socks available for purchase from Smartwool, just look for the logo. Together, we can make a positive impact on the environment.

In January of 1969, after witnessing a massive oil spill in California, Senator Nelson wanted to infuse the energy of student anti-war protests with an emerging air and water pollution public consciousness. Earth Day inspired 20 million Americans - about 10% of the total population at that time - to take to the streets, parks and auditoriums to demonstrate against the impacts of 150 of industrial development. Ham-and-Leek Baked Gnocchi

*A unique way to use up
leftover Easter ham*

INGREDIENTS:

Cooking spray, for ramekins
1 (16 oz.) package gnocchi
1 ½ cups gouda cheese, shredded
1/2 cup finely chopped ham
1 1/4 cups whole milk
3 Tbsp. all-purpose flour
1 garlic clove, chopped
Freshly ground black pepper
2 slices sandwich bread, torn
2 Tbsp. melted unsalted butter
1 leek, sliced and rings separate
Sliced fresh chives, for garnish

DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease four 10 oz ramekins; place on a baking sheet. Combine gnocchi, cheese, and ham in a bowl. Divide evenly in prepared ramekins. Whisk together milk, flour, garlic, and pepper until flour is dissolved. Pour over gnocchi, dividing evenly. Stir together bread and butter in a bowl until coated; toss in leeks. Sprinkle over gnocchi, dividing evenly. Bake until golden brown and bubbly, 34-36 minutes. Let stand 5 minutes before serving. Garnish with chives.

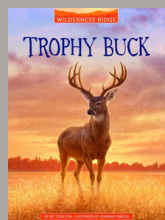
