### Cheesy Garlic Pull Apart Bread

*A quick and easy fancy appetizer!*

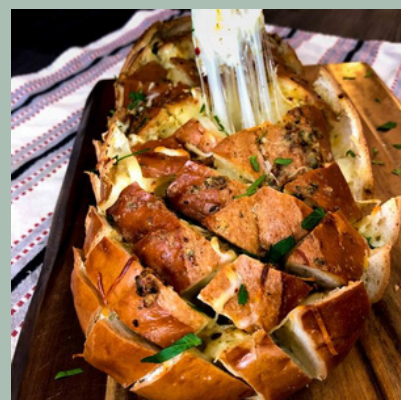
#### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Asiago & Roasted Garlic Dip Mix
- 1 loaf Italian bread
- 8oz Italian cheese blend
- 1 stick butter



#### DIRECTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Cut bread into 1" sections diagonally - careful not to cut all the way through. Carefully tuck cheese between the sections. Melt butter and combine with the mix. Then drizzle the butter mixture over the top of the loaf of bread. Cover in foil and bake for 25 minutes. Uncover the bread and bake for another 10 minutes or until golden brown and the cheese has melted.
